ABSTRACT

Authors are requested to submit to submit online an Abstract of approximately 800 words (2 pages maximum). Abstracts should briefly outline the main features, results and conclusions as well as their general significance and contain relevant references. The Abstract will be reproduced as submitted and unchanged in the Book of Abstracts to be delivered at the Congress to all participants, with the aim at providing a brief and overall insight of the presentation. Full details of the content of the paper can be included in the paper to be published in the CD-ROM Proceedings. The Abstract has to be written in English with a Times-Roman 12 points font single spaced. Within the limitation of 2 pages, figures can be included, if needed. If references are used in the abstract, please use the style described below. The Abstract must contain the full name and full address of author/s. Abstracts can only be accepted on the understanding that they will be presented at the Congress. Only one presentation per participant will be allowed.
